Rule & Notes:

1. No dogs are allowed at either ballpark, in Salem or Payson.
2. If we are presented with weather issues, we will update status on UPG Facebook and insta. Also, on the website.
3. High School Federation rules will govern play in this tournament.
4. Games will be **1 hr and 45 minutes. Pool game will end in a tie. Bracket games** - International tie breaker will be used in extra inning or after time has expired.
5. Pool Game - Home team by rock paper scissors. Bracket Games – High seed is home.
6. The season is young; pitchers will follow UHSAA pitching rules. A maximum of 110 pitches in a day. The pitcher may complete a final batter. More than 60 pitches in a day requires a full calendar day of rest. **Violating the pitch count is a forfeit.** Game changer will be the method of pitch tracking. If a team erases their Game Changer after a game, the pitchers used will be ineligible for the remainder of the tournament. Coaches protect your pitchers. Our medals are nice, but you may need your pitcher later in the season.
7. Portable mounds will be used on most fields. **No metal Spikes on Portable mounds.**
8. Game ending Mercy Rule will be **9 after 5 innings** or **12 after 4 innings.**
9. Players who do not play in at least 2 of the pool play games will not be allowed during bracket play.
10. Bats must have the USSSA or USA stamp – Bats that are on the not approved list are not allowed.
Bats must be BBCOR for 14u age group. – Bats that are on the not approved list are not allowed.
11. Speed up runners for pitcher and catcher are allowed. Last out will be the runner.
12. Birth date deadline is May 1. No play can turn older than the age division prior to May. 8u and 14u do have grade acceptations. 9u to 13u do not have grade acceptations.
13. No slash bunting. This is bush league and will result in a dead ball out, if attempted.
14. 8u and 9u baserunners may leave (steal) at the time of the release. Pitch release.
15. Players are limited to one team per age division.
